Winemaker's Comment:

Lighter on its feet than some Cabernet / Merlot / Shiraz blends, this wine offers ripe berry fruit supported by balanced tannins and soft acids, making it a well rounded "quaffer" to complement most any cuisine. A great companion for burgers, steaks off the Webber or zesty pizza. Day 2 - It's even better, presenting softer and "jammier" with ripe sweet red fruit dominating the palate and a round mouth feel.
